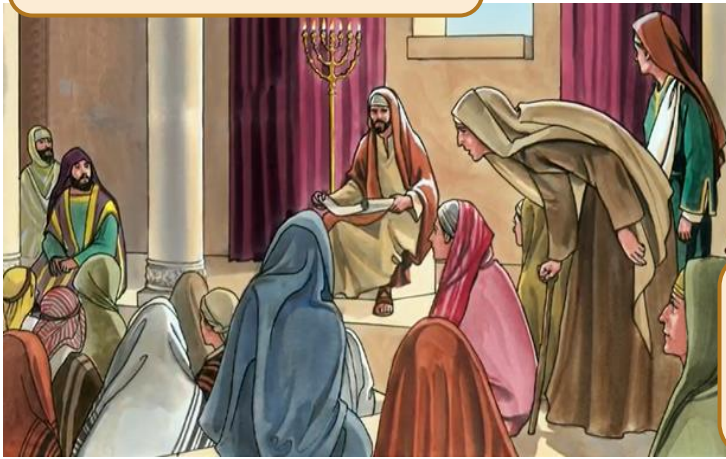

Jesus was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath.

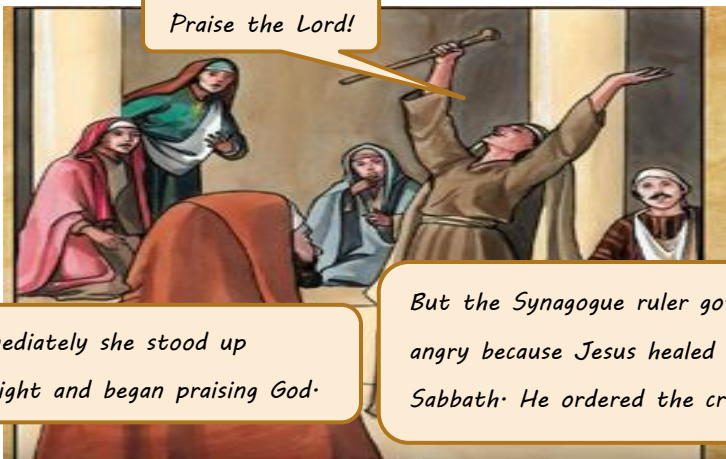
Jesus saw a woman with a spirit that had crippled her for 18 years. She was bent and quite unable to stand up straight.



She called her over and said "Woman, you are freed from your infirmity."

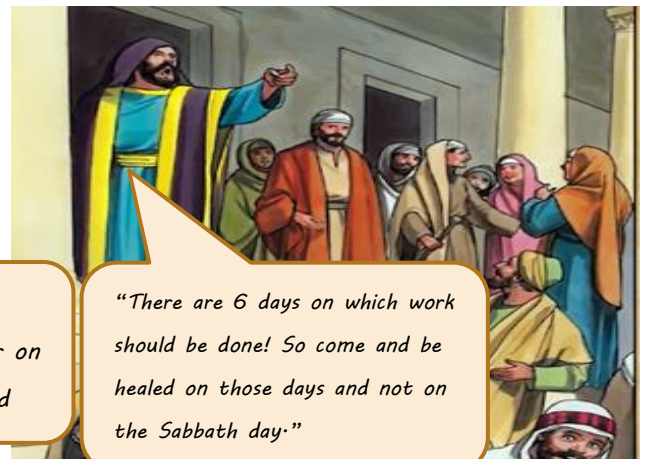
Then he placed his hands on her

Praise the Lord!

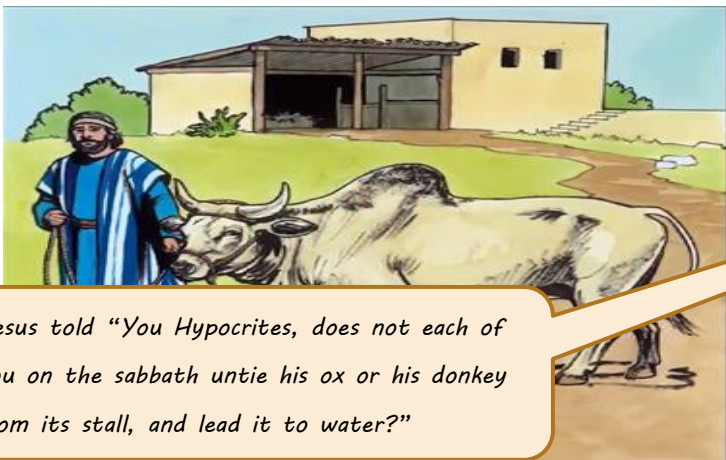


Immediately she stood up straight and began praising God.

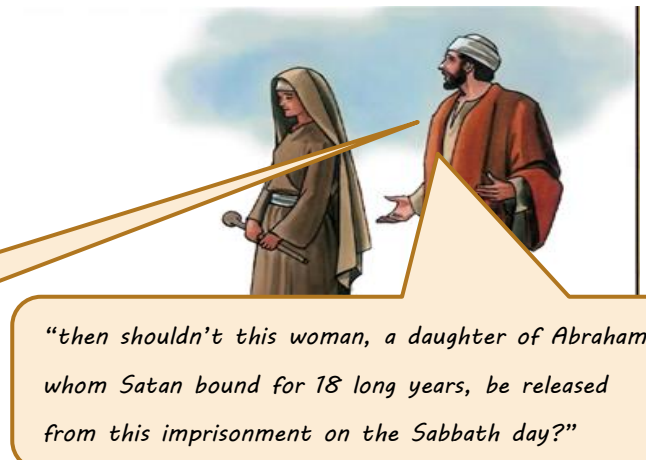
But the Synagogue ruler got angry because Jesus healed her on Sabbath. He ordered the crowd
